Officer & Staff Reports

- President Thank you all for being here, our last meeting with the 2021 Board of Directors. Please be sure to block the time for the Annual General Meeting January 22, 2022. As we all are aware, the COVID Omicron is everywhere, please be careful and safe as we get ready for our AGM and the spring season. Tonight, we will be reviewing Award nominations and discussing the proposed budget amendment. Thank you to everyone, it has been a really great year.
- Executive Director After Carolinas Cup, the focus has been summarizing the tournament financially and operationally, wrapping up finances for 2021, preparing for the AGM and ensuring our league's insurance coverage is properly in place.
- Vice-President 2022 registration numbers are coming in nicely. Working on the 2022
 AGM/Workshops and Registration, all will be discussed later in the agenda.
- Treasurer's Report NCASA had a very positive year, wrapping up 2021 finances with a \$95,000 plus net. Tournament income and expenses are listed on the second page. Celebrate the Tatas, after covering operation costs and donating \$30,000, the tournament was left with a \$3,300 net. The Carolinas Cup also had a positive net.

Review of the Balance sheet P&L statement reflects the growth of 2021.

Approval of Minutes

 Minutes for the December 13, 2021, meeting were approved unanimously as amended to included Charlotte Independence Soccer Club as the third new league to NCASA in 2021.

- Registration Report Registration numbers for 2021 have topped 10,074. This number is a combination of regular player registration and Tournament Only registrations.
- First-Year-League Updates: The three new leagues in NCASA enjoyed a successful first year. NCASA is looking forward to approaching more new leagues in 2022.
- New League Update 2022 potential include a group from Fayetteville, NC; High Country in Boone, NC; La Liga de Coats in Angier, NC; and still want to work with AC Sandhills in Sanford, NC.

Be it resolved that the NCASA Board proposes that the following friendly amendment to the 2022 NCASA Budget beproposed prior to the Council voting to approve the budget at the NCASA Annual General Meeting:
