Quorum determination

Officer & Staff Reports

- President Need to flag a discussion on the Constitution and Bylaw revision and update. We will be delaying
 the discussion until the April meeting where the discussion will be brought forward. Donna Langdon is still
 offering the opportunity for one-on-one discussions on any areas of concern.
- Executive Director As spring kicks off, assisting leagues get started has been a focus. Working with Affinity to unravel issues that certain glitches are causing. Preparing tracking methods for our Insurance Claims, Discipline and Appeals hearings and SafeSport compliance.
- Vice-President No Report
- Treasurer's Report P&L Statements and Balance Sheet have been submitted and circulated. The Balance Sheet shows NCASA in a healthy financial position.

One area that the treasurer will take to the finance committee for discussion will be the pattern of payment to USASA. USASA has passed a new policy only requiring payments every quarter. NCASA treasurer wants to consider returning to paying every 60 days to always have a more accurate and current understanding of NCASA's financial position.

Approval of Minutes

Minutes for the February 21, 2022, meeting were approved unanimously.

Growth Initiative

- Registration Report NCASA is experiencing strong registration numbers. As of March 14, 2022, there are 5403 registered players. There is a 44% increase from the same time in 2021. Maintaining the trending growth numbers could see NCASA reaching 11-12 thousand players by the end of 2022.
- First-Year-League Updates there are no first-year leagues
- New League Update The leadership from La Liga de Coats have not yet made a decision about affiliating.

Competitions

- Carolinas Cup Registration is strong for the Memorial Day event. 33 teams, 7 NC, 15 SC, 2 GA, 2 MD, 1 NJ, 4 OH, 1 PA and 1 TN. Planning is on target. The one NJ team is a women's over 40 team. ABASA and SC are working on two Over 40 teams.
- VP Men's Competition, Scott Eisenbraun is holding a Zoom call to prepare teams for the USASA Region III National Championships.
- Celebrate the Tatas Committee meetings have been scheduled. Working on locking down the date and location.

- D&A There are two abuse cases before the NCASA D&A committee. NCASA will be offering minimum suspension in lieu of a hearing.

Old Business

(New) Player Accident Insurance & D&A tracking spreadsheets – USI and AG are USASA's new insurance providers. There have been some communication issues between players and insurance company. NCASA will be tracking the flow of claims from date of accident, date received and submitted to insurance and when the players receive their acknowledgement letter to begin submitting bills. This will provide NCASA a tool to assist players and to communicate back to the insurance company with issues.

Since last year's volume of D&A issues, NCASA will begin tracking the cases to ensure a timely resolution of each case. This will also show where the delays occur in the efforts to prevent any backlog.

(New) SafeSport policy implementation – NCASA has met the criteria for posting. Most of NCASA's board have completed their SafeSport training. Many leagues have done a good job but there is still a long way to go to have

all leagues in compliance. The office will begin working with one league at time assisting with their posting and helping get their officers to take the training.

(New) D&O Policies – NCASA and our leagues are all covered for 2022 by D&O policies purchased by NCASA. Communication has begun to our leagues as reminders that for 2023 coverage, leagues will need to decide if they want to continue to carry the coverage and purchase it on their own. NCASA can aid leagues that want to purchase their own coverage with the application process.

(Old) USSF AGM – USSF Presidential Election – The AGM was sparsely attended because the substantive meetings were all held virtually. There were many technical errors going on throughout the National Council Meeting, including issues with the communication between those that were live and those that were communicating through the online function.

Cindy Parlow was re-elected. This election was the closest USSF Presidential election ever; 52% to 48%.
