Officer & Staff Reports

President – Welcome everyone, hope everyone has had an enjoyable summer.
 The USASA Adult Soccer Fest just concluded their weeklong tournament in Greensboro. It was a very positive event. NCASA had many teams competing and several officers participating at different levels, volunteering or playing or both.

Tonight's meeting related to USASA Adult Soccer Fest, the finance committee did approve a \$2,000.00 sponsorship of the USASA Adult Soccer Fest. Following our budget policies, we will vote to ratify the action of the Finance Committee.

Two other topics, one is a new membership category for USASA, tournament organizations that operate in multiple states. The second is the state-wide league, is this an area that the board feels NCASA should enter. As First Flight has requested operational assistance and UPSL continues to grow, this may be a good time for NCASA to establish an equivalent competitive league.

- Executive Director The office has been busy. The D&A committee has been focused on clearing the docket. This is full swing for tournament season, so a large portion of time has been assisting the USASA Adult Soccer Fest and processing Queen City and Beer City registrations.
- Executive Vice President Attended Adult Soccer Fest, watch matches during the day and volunteered at the Player Celebration Party.
 Worked closely with Laura Collins and Susan Morecroft on varying topics of league management. Held a call with Team pass to address long-standing action-items and where are they on the list. One item on the programing list was a Spanish version.
- Treasurer Treasurer report submitted circulated. NCASA is in a strong financial position.

- Registration Report Registration is very healthy. Many leagues are already opening Fall registrations. NCASA annual passes are over 10,000 as of this meeting and the Tournament Only passes have broken 1000 and there is still a lot of growth to come.

- New League Update Laura Collins and Susan Morecroft will be launching a new women's league, Wake Women's Soccer League in Apex. The league will have 11 v 11 Over 30 and Over 40 divisions.

Scott Eisenbraun – Huge thanks to NC Fusion, they had their staff do 90% of the set up with tents, flags and pop ups which was a tremendous help. NC Fusion were very active partners in ensuring the event ran smoothly. Wednesday morning the Today's Show was filming the Over 70 women's game and Scott's son was invited by USASA President John Motta to referee the match. The airing of the segment will happen after the Women's World Cup.

Chad Garber – Refereeing was fantastic, the beer garden was supreme, communicating about changes in the schedule was poor. USASA did try to improve. Besides the heat, we had a great time.

Sam Cohen – A big thank you to everyone who was there and representing NCASA. USASA communicated that the event will return to Greensboro in 2024 which will give the opportunity to be even better.

Ratification of Finance Committee Approval of Spending for Soccer Fest Sponsorship

Whereas the USASA Adult Soccer Fest tournament (Soccer Fest) is being held this year from July 12-16 at the Bryan Park Truist Soccer Complex in Greensboro, NC, and

Whereas, the Soccer Fest organizers had indicated an interest in obtaining NCASA's financial assistance in defraying the costs of the Friday night tournament party, and

Whereas, the NCASA Board discussed this issue at its June Board meeting and was generally supportive of providing this assistance, and

Whereas, the written request for sponsorship was not received from Soccer Fest until July 6, and Whereas, reflecting the NCASA Board's prior discussion, the NCASA Finance Committee authorized the expenditure of \$2,000 in funds to sponsor the tournament party, and

Whereas, the Budgetary Spending Authority Policy calls for spending authorized by the Finance Committee to be presented to the full NCASA Board for ratification at the first NCASA Board meeting after the Finance Committee has approved additional spending,

Be it resolved that NCASA ratifies the Finance Committee decision to approve the expenditure of \$2,000 from the General Fund for sponsorship of the USASA Adult Soccer Fest tournament party.
