## Officer & Staff Reports

President – Happy New Year!

Look forward to seeing everyone at the AGM soon. As I sent out earlier, the vote was to hold our workshops and AGM at the hotel. We will begin communicating to our league Presidents and Officers and getting all the operational aspects inline.

An email was sent from Region III requesting a last-minute meeting for this evening. Region III attached flyers regarding the Region III National Cup qualifying. There is an increase in the entry fee from \$350 to \$500 and they have added an Over 50s division. This is mentioned because NCASA has built our 2024 Proposed Budget based on a \$350 entry fee that was announced in the Fall of 2023 and did not account for any Over 50s teams participating. We may need to make a supplement to the budget later this spring.

The big item on the agenda tonight is the NCASA Awards.

One final item to my report and that is has been wonderful serving on this board with all of you this past year. This is the last meeting of the 2023 board year and I wanted to take a moment to say how I appreciate all the work all of you have done this year and what a pleasure it has been to work with all of you. We have deliberated and debated many topics, and even in disagreements we have been able to come together for the betterment of soccer in NC.

 Executive Director – AGM preparation has been the main focus, logistics such as hotels, meals, membership book, reports and preparing awards nominations.
 Cindy and Donna have worked hard on ensuring that NCASA is not paying for duplicated registrations as the final 2023 payment is made to USASA.

Since Florida Classic and Beer City Cup have opened registration and expect players to upload their current registration or purchase a tournament pass from the tournament. NCASA has opened the Annual Pass registration and has communicated to leagues and players to get them registered and avoid unnecessary and additional costs.

NCASA has been working with USASA to create an online Player Accident Claim process that will increase efficiency on filing and processing to get the players their benefits quicker. NCASA has been involved in several test runs of the new online claims process. After January 14, 2024 USASA will no longer accept paper claim forms.

Fields for the 2024 Celebrate the Tatas event has been secured.

- Executive Vice President Developing an Emergency Action Plan.to assist with on field
  emergencies. TeamPass has added an emergency contact list to accompany the roster for
  players and guest players. Research has been done to address 4 main areas of concern:
  cardiac, respiratory, head injuries and environmental. Once the draft is completed, leagues can
  adopt it and post it on their website for captains to be better prepared in case of an emergencies.
- Treasurer Treasurer's Report has been circulated. Registration and income surpassed expectations.
