Officer & Staff Reports

 President – Since we last met, NCASA has held a very successful Carolinas Cup. Our largest Cup ever with 76 teams. A huge thank you to everyone who contributed to the success, Darius and Cindy, Scott Eisenbraun and his children, Jeremy as one of the referee coordinators, Donna Langdon, Alex Vidaurri, the volunteers, and our South Carolina partners. It was a complete teamwork effort. A big capstone to the year.

For tonight's meeting, two important items, one, the 2024 NCASA Budget to approve, we will cover details later in the meeting. The budget is straight forward, including many of the traditional line items and adding funds to areas we can supplement due to last year's registration numbers. NCASA's approach to the registration numbers is conservative to ensure that any items added to the budget are sustainable as we grow.

The other important topic for discussion will be how NCASA will structure the Annual General Meeting being held January 27-28, 2024. The main questions will be; are we holding a one-day or two-day event, which also ties to the question: will NCASA be joining NCYSA and NCSRA on January 27th and/or January 28th. Plus, Saturday night will be the NC Soccer Hall of Fame Induction Banquet.

The last thing to mention, tonight's meeting is our last board meeting of 2023, but NCASA will hold a meeting January 8th to wrap up the year and to vote on NCASA Award recipients.

 Executive Director – Since our November meeting, preparing for the Carolinas Cup, hosting the event, and summarizing the Cup finances and survey has been a large focus for November and into December. The office has worked with our Treasurer and Finance committee building the 2024 NCASA Budget.

After the Carolinas Cup, December 6th, NCASA traveled to Charlotte to present our Celebrate the Tatas donation of \$27,500 to both the Levine Cancer Institute and the Novant Health Foundation.

Reviewed hotel and meeting space options for the NCASA AGM.

NCASA has sent out two communications to the full membership, the Awards Nomination notification with nomination forms and awards description, and the NCASA Election notification outlining positions that are up for election and the responsibilities associated with each position.

NCASA was invited to assist USASA in developing an online insurance claim process.

Continuing to work on the statewide league, the NCSL. Website needs some work and reviewing the rules and regulations before announcing.

- Executive Vice President Due to the rise of emergency incidents at the field, working on a
 Generic Emergency Plan that addresses cardiac event action plan and other areas of
 emergency. Researching defibrillators, defibrillator programs and CPR classes. The goal will be
 to have a guide of best practices for leagues.
- Treasurer Treasurer's Report has been circulated. Player registration Income is 21% higher than budgeted and the Tournament Only Registration was 141.6% higher than estimated. The Carolinas Cup and Celebrate the Tatas also exceeded previous year participation, and the Celebrate the Tatas surpassed previous year donation levels.

Growth Initiative

- Registration Report The numbers are fantastic. NCASA recorded 12,252 Annual Players Registrations and 2243 Tournament Only Player Registrations, bringing our total registration to 14,495.
- First Year Leagues Update Wake Women's Soccer League has had a great inaugural season, 106 players. Looking forward to spring season.
- New League Update The Winston-Salem Pick up league has continued talks with NCASA exploring what membership would look like for a pickup league that does not need rosters or referees.

Competitions

- Carolinas Cup The Carolinas Cup was a huge success. The Cup Committee needs to get together to review the good and the bad. An event this large shows deficits that need to be addressed.
- Celebrate the Tatas No Report

Organizing Committees

- D&A Committee There are two remaining cases that need to be addressed. The D&A committee will be discussing an updated D&A manual.
- Budget Committee Thank you to the Finance Committee for their work on the 2024 Budget.
- AGM Committee Will be discussed later in the meeting.
- Nomination Committee Nomination forms have been sent to all members; several nominations have been submitted.
- NCASA Awards Committee Requests for award recipients have been sent to the full membership and there are submissions for most categories.

NCASA is still obtaining final costs, but the proposed budget appropriation should be sufficient to cover all options. A survey will be sent to all Board members to determine preference for the location at which each day's events will be held.
